## Terms and Conditions

PLEASE BE ADVISED that the purchase and/or use of a Ticket to, and/or entry to the Event shall constitute Your unconditional acceptance to be bound by any, and all, of the terms and conditions contained within this agreement (this "Agreement") between You and Bandon RFC to attend all or part of the Event. This ticket is non-transferable to any other person than those named on the application/consent form. If you are unable to attend you must contact the organisers and inform them. Your ticket **CANNOT be used by another** as your emergency contact details will not be appropriate for anyone else.

**TICKETS CAN ONLY BE PURCHASED BY PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF THE ATTENDEE WITH THE APPROPRIATE BANDON RFC-BOUNCE CONSENT FORM COMPLETED. IF A PARENT CANNOT ATTEND PERSONALLY THEN AN APPROPRIATE ADULT (ie not an older sibling) CAN PURCHASE ON THEIR BEHALF ONCE THEY PRESENT A FORM SIGNED BY THE PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE CHILD.**

**PLEASE NOTE: Cars are our preferred means of transport to and from the event.**

You must possess a valid Ticket or wristband that permits access.

**EVENTBRITE BARCODE:** No duplicate scans for Eventbrite barcode – the second scan when rejected will result in that child not gaining entry. Ensure original barcodes are presented. Irrespective of the originality of the second scan barcode, the second child will **NOT** be admitted. Further appropriate payment and parental consent forms may be required.

For safety reasons, Bandon RFC, at their discretion, reserves the right to, without any prior notice or compensation to You: postpone, cancel, interrupt or stop the Event; provisionally keep visitors on the Event site at the end of the Event; totally or partially vacate the Event site; and deny access to the Event site regardless of the possession of a valid entry ticket. If the actions as mentioned above are required, no interaction will be entered into regarding refund of monies paid.

The Bounce event run by Bandon RFC is one of a few events in West Cork that allows minors to attend without being accompanied by a parent or guardian. The Terms and Conditions are a guide for parents and attendees as to what to expect when one attends. We want our children, children from the locality and any other children coming to the Event to enjoy themselves under the supervision of all Volunteers, Security, Gardaí in a safe manner. It affords this age group a focal point to meet and socialise. We believe that in this social media era that it is vital for our children to be able to develop their person to person skills in a sheltered environment. We believe that this Event is an ideal opportunity.

There will be a strong Gardaí presence as well as numerous Security Guards at the Event. If any patron is found with illicit drugs, patrons will be treated the same way as anywhere else and they will be referred to the appropriate authorities, potentially facing criminal charges.

At the Event, there will be camera surveillance (CCTV) for the purpose of ensuring the safety and proper operation of the Event. The Footage will be stored by Bandon RFC and potentially used for the purpose of ensuring the security and safety of Event attendees and the enforcement of and compliance with the safety regulations on the Event site. Should the Gardaí require it, CCTV footage will be available to Gardaí to complete any investigation they deem appropriate. The purchase of a ticket constitutes your acceptance that any and all footage may be used by Bounce/Bandon RFC or by the Gardaí as they deem appropriate.

Tickets are purchased under the following Conditions of entry. Non-compliance with any condition may at the discretion of Bandon RFC constitute a voiding of your ticket without refund. The conditions include but are not limited to:

- Bandon RFC/Bounce reserve the right to refuse entry to any person.
- Certain contact details regarding the parent/guardian of the attendee needs to be provided at time of ticket purchase.  
Parent/Guardian Name & contact mobile (in case of emergency), Parent/Guardian email address – a copy of the Terms and

Conditions as well as any further arrangements or instructions will be sent to all parents. This is mandatory as in case of emergency we will require all appropriate contact details for the guardians of the children.

- In case of emergency parents will need to be aware if their child has any allergic reaction to medicines and any other specific medical requirements should the need arise.
- All bags, belongings, containers and other possessions must be available for search upon entry to the event.
- Patrons are not allowed to bring ANY liquids onsite either open or unopened. Liquid Medicines specifically required by any Patron must be made aware to the organisers prior to the event and announced at point of entry.
- All patrons will be subject to a 'pat-down' by security, and if deemed necessary a metal detector search upon entry.
- Patrons will be evicted from the event without refund if they participate in but not limited to dangerous activities such as:
  - Are under the influence or in possession of illegal drugs or any other illegal substances.
  - Have alcohol on their person or are clearly suffering from alcohol intoxication which, in the Events staff's sole discretion, has caused You to be in an impaired state.
  - Are demonstrating an intent to disturb the peace or to provoke someone else to do so Engage in fighting or disruptive behaviour.
  - Use foul language.
  - Resist the direction of and search by the Event security guards and security services.
  - Refuse to declare and forfeits objects that are prohibited, as set forth herein.
  - Act in violation of the provisions of one or more articles of these regulations or in the spirit thereof.
  - Aggressive behaviour
  - Aggressive dancing
  - Moshing
  - Crowd surfing
  - Climbing
  - Weapons of any kind (regardless of permit)
  - Fireworks, sparklers, or incendiary devices
  - Kites, Glowsticks, Laser pointers etc.
  - Pets, unless you are a person with disabilities requiring a service animal.
  - Sharp objects
  - Disturb the peace, demonstrate an intent to disturb the peace or provoke someone else to do so, or compromise the safety of the general public.
  - Deface, mark, damage, tear down or otherwise destroy, in whole or in part, any of the decorations or part of the Event site/structure.
  - Other activities not listed but deemed dangerous in the opinion of the organisers or Security personnel.
- Bounce has put into action 'restricted capacities' for the main building, meaning that once the maximum capacity for that area has been reached, there will be no more admissions until other patrons exit the main building. Patrons outside can remain in the open area at the front of the building.
- Anyone found supplying alcohol to minors will be evicted from the venue and may face criminal charges.
- No pass outs – once you're in, you're in; once you're out, you're out!
- For a wristband event – these are single use. Anyone found attempting to give wristbands to other persons will be evicted without refund.

- If a minor has an incident or is deemed to be under the influence of alcohol they will be quarantined in the Medical Room and their parents called. A responsible adult should be available to collect the minor and remove them from the event. At all times persons in charge will be acting “in loco parentis” until contact can be made with parents and as such the best interest for the child’s safety at all times will be the deciding factor even if the child does not see that this is the best course of action.
  - Details of the adults contact details MUST be supplied at time of ticket purchase.
  - These numbers will be contacted at random prior to the event to validate parent’s numbers. In the event that numbers supplied are bogus or not parent’s/guardian’s numbers then the ticket may be voided without refund should alternative parent/guardian details not be procured.
- Bounce will act according to the law and in cases of trespass (fence jumping).
- If the Event is cancelled in whole, or in part, due to a Force Majeure Event (as defined below), You will not be entitled to a refund. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Bandon RFC/Bounce may issue, at their sole and absolute discretion, a partial or full refund of Your Ticket, by accounting for, among other considerations, the extent and nature of the cancellation. A “Force Majeure Event” shall mean an act of God, act of terrorism, flood, tsunami, strike or other labour condition or dispute, an order or injunction of any court or administrative body or any other act of public authority, severe weather threatening the safety of Event attendees or similar contingency or unexpected event, and any such occurrence beyond the reasonable control. You understand that in all instances, the maximum remedy You may receive for any cancellation of any part of the Event, if any, will be the face value of Your Ticket, excluding all fees and/or service charges paid by You in connection with the purchase of Your Ticket.
- **REFUND POLICY:**
  - Further to the details above, you may receive a refund if the purchaser applies back to the email address [bandonrfc.bounce@gmail.com](mailto:bandonrfc.bounce@gmail.com) Full refund applies for 7 days notice. 75% applies for 4 days, 50% for 3 days and no refund less than three days. For exceptional reasons Bandon RFC Bounce will make decisions on a case by case basis.
  - Online ticket refunds up to 1 day before the event,
- Only purchase tickets from Bandon RFC/Bounce Official Sales points. Check Bounce Facebook & Instagram pages for details. If you purchase from another source, you risk purchasing a counterfeit or invalid ticket. Bandon RFC is not responsible for tickets purchased from unofficial sources. In no event will forged tickets be honoured or eligible for a refund.
- In order to enter into the Event, You must have Your own valid Ticket. One Ticket is required per attendee and will only be valid for the Event.
- Your Ticket is not redeemable for cash. There will be no replacements for Tickets that are lost, stolen, destroyed or damaged and You unconditionally accept the risk of damage to, loss of and/or theft of Your Ticket.
